President's Message

Lately we've been getting calls regarding an odor in the hot water. This condition is caused when harmless sulfur and sulfates produce hydrogen sulfide gas as a byproduct of their metabolism. It is this gas that causes the odor in the hot water.

Hot water heaters have anode rods in them to neutralize the corrosive action softened water and oxidizing organic matter has on water heaters. While neutralizing the corrosive action, these rods give off electrons which act as catalysts while they reduce sulfurs to hydrogen sulfide. This catalyst accelerates the reducing process. The odor then becomes noticeable. Specify well water anode when you buy a heater. Anodes made of magnesium tend to be more troublesome than their counterparts. Zinc anodes are supposed to be more compatible.

Solution

Periodic flushing of the water heater with common household bleach such as Clorox is usually effective or remove existing anode, flush tank, install new anode rod. Anode rod total removal probably voids heater warranty. As a reminder, turn off the main water supply and relieve water pressure.

Hydrant Flushing

Just around the corner spring will be here and it will be time for hydrant flushing. We will be doing the flushing in April so keep an eye out for the signs that will be posted on several corners. There will be more details in the April bulletin along with what you as a homeowner need to do when the hydrants are flushed.
