

# **School's in Session**

We would like to remind residents that Sheriff's deputies will be stationed in school zones to enforce speed limits, cell phone use, seat belt use, child safety restraint laws, passing stopped school buses, reckless driving behavior, and other traffic laws.

# **Crime Prevention Alert**

Sheriff Zaruba would like to remind the citizens of DuPage County to remain vigilant in preventing crime. Specifically, there has been an increase in stolen motor vehicles in DuPage County over the past three months. The suspects in these crimes are searching for unlocked vehicles with the keys to the vehicles left inside. In some instances the thieves are entering the homes of vehicle owners via the garage door openers found in unlocked vehicles and searching for the keys to the vehicle and then stealing them. These vehicle thefts are occurring during the overnight hours. In addition to stealing the vehicles the thieves are stealing purses and wallets and then using the identity and credit cards of the victims while traveling in their stolen vehicle. Sheriff Zaruba asks that you help to protect yourself and your families by always locking your vehicles and keeping your outside residential lighting on. Additionally, never leave the keys to your vehicle inside of it and do not leave garage door openers inside of vehicles parked outside. Anyone who observes a criminal act in progress or acting suspiciously is asked to call 911 immediately and to not take any action that would place them in danger.

# 2016 Outside Water Use Regulations

During the period between May 15 – September 15, or as otherwise specified by the LPHOA Board of Directors, the sprinkling of lawns and gardens, or ANY outside water usage, shall be limited in the following manner:

Washington, Park and 41<sup>st</sup> Streets – Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday Ogden, Liberty Blvd. and Williams Street – Monday, Wednesday, Friday

The above streets have outside water use privileges only on the days and hours stated. Days will alternate each year and there is **NO SUNDAY USE**. More than one hose, sprinkling systems and LPHOA water individual storage tanks **ARE PROHIBITED**. Sprinkling cans filled at the spigot may be use anytime. No other special permits will be issued. Anyone violating these regulations shall be assessed a fine of \$25.00 for the first violation, subsequent violations will be \$50.00 for each violation. These fines are subject to change depending upon water conditions prevailing. **NO WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN**. Fines will be added to the LPHOA Maintenance Assessment.

# LPHOA Fall Hydrant/Main Flushing

#### Mark your Calendars

Friday, September 30th beginning at 8:45 p.m. Rain Date – October 7th

The next day after the flushing, please follow the procedures below to ensure proper home plumbing maintenance.

- Drain hot water tank from bottom spigot with a hose if necessary until the water runs clear.
- Flush the inside plumbing by removing all inside faucet screens and turning on all inside faucets until the water runs clear.
- Regenerate water softener, etc.
- Change any water filter cartridge.

We recommend that you do not wash clothes after 8:00 p.m. on the night of the flush and not until you have completed the procedures above. If you experience any discolored water, please repeat the procedures again.

#### **Brush Pick-Up**

DG Township: October 11th

York Twp.: 1st full week of the month Brush Definition: Branches and bushes,

shrubs and trees, no bags.

Brush is to be placed on the parkway no earlier than one week before the pickup is scheduled to start in each area, and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the date pickup begins. All brush must be under 6 feet long and 3 inches in diameter, bundled with string or twine (not wire) and not to exceed 25 lbs. or 18 inches in diameter. Items that do not conform will not be picked up. It will be the sole responsibility of the homeowner to dispose of them.

#### **Skunk Encounters**

If you or your pet has had an unpleasant visit from a skunk, you might want to try this remedy to eliminate the aroma. This mixture works on dogs, clothing, vehicles and you. It's important NOT to add or use any water. Mix together: 1 quart of 3% hydrogen peroxide, ¼ cup baking soda and 1 teaspoon dawn dish liquid. Mix & use to shampoo, avoid eyes, rinse well and repeat. Discard unused portion & do not store.
