President's Message

Common Sense Rules
Outside Water Use Regulations for Summer 2017

During the period of May 15th thru September 15th or as otherwise specified by the LPHOA Board of Directors, the sprinkling of lawns and gardens, or **ANY** outside water usage, shall be limited in the following manner:

Washington, Park, 41st Street Monday, Wednesday, Friday

Ogden, Liberty Blvd., Williams Street Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

Hours: 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

The above streets have outside water use privileges only on the days and hours stated.

Days alternate each year.

NO SUNDAY USE!

More than one hose, sprinkling systems, and LPHOA water individual storage tanks are prohibited. On a one-time basis **WITH LPHOA APPROVAL**, swimming pools using more than 1500 gallons of water may be filled after 10:00 p.m. but **NOT IN JULY OR AUGUST**.

Sprinkling cans filled at the spigot may be used anytime.

No other special permits will be issued.

Anyone violating these regulations shall be assessed a fine of \$25.00 for the first violation. Subsequent violations will be \$50.00 for each violation. These fines are subject to change depending upon water conditions prevailing. **NO WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN!** Fines will be added to the LPHOA Maintenance Assessment.

The LPHOA knows that having an ample supply of water is a top priority in an emergency. In case of an emergency where we might lose power at the pump house, we have a back-up generator that will continue to provide water to all the residents on the LPHOA water system.

Water Conservation

How much water do you lose from a dripping faucet?

2 drips per second per 1 week = 26 gallons 1/16" stream per 1 week = 575 gallons 3/16" stream per 1 week = 3000 gallons 3/16" stream per 1 month = 12,750 gallons

LPHOA Spring Hydrant/Main Flushing

Mark your Calendars

Friday, April 28th beginning at 8:45 p.m. Rain Date – May 5th

The next day after the flushing, please follow the procedures below to ensure proper home plumbing maintenance.

- Drain hot water tank from bottom spigot with a hose if necessary until the water runs clear.
- Flush the inside plumbing by removing all inside faucet screens and turning on all inside faucets until the water runs clear.
- Regenerate water softener, etc.
- Change any water filter cartridge.

We recommend that you do not wash clothes after 8:00 p.m. on the night of the flush and not until you have completed the procedures above. If you experience any discolored water, please repeat the procedures again.

Place on parkway no earlier than 1 week before scheduled pick up and no later than 7:30 a.m. on the date pickup begins.

York Township

May thru October

Tornado Weather

Tornado season will soon be upon us, so be prepared. A watch means conditions are right to produce a tornado and a warning means a tornado has been spotted, take shelter immediately. Basement or interior room on the lowest floor level is best, avoiding windows and exterior walls. Have a flashlight, battery operated radio and a first aid kit available for an emergency.
