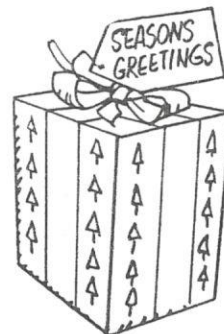

Holiday Safety

*Fresh trees are less likely to catch fire, so look for a tree with vibrant green needles that are hard to pluck and the branches don't easily break.

*Always place your tree away from heat sources like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or lights. Keep the tree base filled with water to avoid it getting dry.

*Make sure all your indoor and outdoor Christmas lights have been tested for safety and throw out any damaged lights.

*Even a well-watered tree should be taken down after 4 weeks. If you've decorated your real tree right after Thanksgiving, it should be discarded the week after Christmas, not New Year's Day.
