LPHOA Board Elections

Do you know what qualifications are required to become a LPHOA Board Member? Qualifications include....

- * Resident connected to the LPHOA public water system for at least (1) year.
- * LPHOA member in good standing.
- * Shall have attended a minimum of (4) meetings during the fiscal year.
- * Only one member of an immediate family living in the same household shall hold elective office.

The LPHOA President will appoint a Nominating Committee to make recommendations of qualified members for election in November. Any LPHOA Member in good standing may nominate a qualified member for elective office.

2018 Outside Water Use Regulations

During the period between May 15 – September 15, or as otherwise specified by the LPHOA Board of Directors, the sprinkling of lawns and gardens, or ANY outside water usage, shall be limited in the following manner:

Washington, Park and 41st Streets – Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday
Ogden, Liberty Blvd. and Williams Street – Monday, Wednesday, Friday
The above streets have outside water use privileges only on the days and hours stated.
Days will alternate each year and there is NO SUNDAY USE. More than one hose or sprinkling systems ARE PROHIBITED. Rain barrels are permitted. Sprinkling cans filled at the spigot may be used anytime. No other special permits will be issued. Anyone violating these regulations shall be assessed a fine of \$25.00 for the first violation, subsequent violations will be \$50.00 for each violation. These fines are subject to change depending upon water conditions prevailing. NO WARNINGS

WILL BE GIVEN. Fines will be added to the LPHOA Maintenance Assessment.

Be a Good Neighbor

There have been many complaints mentioned to LPHOA regarding the unkempt front yards throughout the subdivision. Several front yards are cluttered with items that belong in the back yard and yet they permanently remain in the front yard. Please think of your neighbors and prospective home buyers who may wish to live in our nice community. If your yard is not cleaned up in a timely manner, notices will be sent. Overgrown yards are not only an eyesore but a community safety issue. Weeded lots give impression no one cares for the neighborhood.
