New outside water usage regulation information for Summe2022. From May 15th to September 15th LPHOA community is under water restrictions for outside water usage. We ask that the community follow the watering schedule listed below to help reduce water usage during this time.

Washington	Tues, Thur and Saturday	6:00 A.M -9:00 A.M OR 6:00 P.M - 9 P.M.
Park	Tues, Thur and Saturday	6:00 A.M -9:00 A.M OR 6:00 P.M - 9 P.M.
41st street	Tues, Thur and Saturday	6:00 A.M -9:00 A.M OR 6:00 P.M - 9 P.M.

<u>Please be advised that we have no usage on Mondays</u> for any street. Days will also alternate every year.

No more than one hose or sprinkling system at a time per home.

Individual storage tanks are prohibited.

Swimming pools may be filled once with the approval of the LPHOA. Swimming pools using more than 1,500 gallons of water may be filled after 10:00 P.M. but not in July or August.

Watering cans may be filled at the spigot.

The LPHOA encourages homeowners to use rain barrels to water gardens when possible.

The LPHOA thanks homeowners for following the schedule above. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Board of Directors.

FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING

Mark your calendars for the next hydrant flushing on September 23rd, 2022, from 8:45 P.M until midnight.

If we experience rain, the next date to flush the hydrants will be October 1st, 2022, from 8:45 P.M. until midnight.

While the board is flushing the hydrants, we ask that homeowners refrain from doing laundry. The LPHOA will send out a text alert prior to flushing the hydrants and will post reminders on the community Facebook page.

Recommendations on what homeowners should do the day after the hydrant flush.

- 1. Drain the hot water tank from the bottom spigot until water runs clear.
- 2. Remove all screens from the faucets inside your home and turn on the water until it runs clear.
- 3. Regenerate the water softener.
- 4. Change any filtration system filters in your home.

2022 BRUSH PICK UP

Downers Grove Township brush pick up schedule: Spring brush pick up is the week of May 23rd, 2022 Fall brush pick up is the week of October 3rd, 2022

York Township brush pick up schedule: Pick up schedule is first week of each month between May 3^{rd} to October 8^{th} , 2022

Please keep in mind that brush pick up is only trimmings from trees, bushes, and shrubs.

Trimmings must be bundled with twine or string. No bundles will be accepted if bundled with wire or cable.

Please make sure that all branches are no longer than six feet long. Only branches with a four inch or less diameter will be picked up.

You must have your bundled brush on your parkway no later than 7:00 A.M. on Monday morning of the scheduled pick-up week. Brush bundles put out after 7:00 A.M. will not be picked up and will have to wait until the next pick up.

Trash cans and large items should not be placed on the street prior to 24 hours before the pickup. Weekly scheduled scavenger pickup dates are every Monday except when there is a holiday. All cans should be removed from the street that evening or the next day.

STOP MOSQUITO DEVELOPMENT

Mosquito larva and pupae cannot survive without water. If a water source evaporates before they can transform into adult mosquitos, the young will often die. Please dump any standing water and make sure your rain barrels are covered. Depending on the location, species, and temperature, mosquitos can live from one week to several months. The Township is spraying our community for mosquitos.

Fun fact: Mosquitos are attracted to smelly feet and can fly an estimated distance of one to one and a half miles per hour.
